

Martin County Geocaching Trail

Where Your Adventure Begins!





What is geocaching? Geocaching is a real-world, outdoor treasure hunting game using GPS-enabled devices. Participants navigate to a specific set of GPS coordinates and then attempt to find the geocache (container) hidden at that location. Participants can use a handheld GPS unit, or simply install an application on their smart phones. Many GPS units designed for automobiles can also be used for geocaching. What is the Martin County Geocaching Trail? Geocaching points are set up at 10 locations across Martin County. At each location, unlock the treasure box (pictured in the lower right corner of the page) using the code provided below, take one coin per person, sign the log book (optional), and reset the combination by turning the dials to a different code. (Large groups such as summer camps, Scout groups and 4-H Clubs, take one coin per location to represent your whole group.) When you collect all 10 coins, trade them in for a prize pack including souvenirs from Martin County and its towns! The geocaching locations will be changed every 6 months, so make sure you are using the current guide.

How to claim your prize pack:

Include your name, mailing address and t-shirt size (S, M, L, XL, XXL) when redeeming the coins so we can send your prize pack. (We reserve the right to replace the t-shirt with another prize.) Scout groups, summer camps, 4-H clubs, etc. take one coin per location for your group and indicate how many people are in your group when redeeming the coins. (These groups will receive patches for each child in place of t-shirts, with a t-shirt provided to the group leader if available.) You must collect all 10 coins to receive the prize pack. You have four options for redeeming the coins:

- 1. Scan the coins to a computer as a PDF, JPEG, or PNG file and email to tourism@visitmartincounty.com.
- 2. Make a copy of the coins and fax to (252)792-0993 including ATTN: Tourism Development Authority on the cover page.
- 3. Make a copy of the coins and mail to: Martin County Tourism Development Authority P.O. Box 382 Williamston, NC 27892
